



### REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR REGISTRATION

**All the documents must be in English and/or Turkish. Otherwise the application will not be accepted.**

- 1) Copy of a valid test score paper (Turkish or English translation) (Please check below to see the accepted test scores.)
- 2) Copy of High School Diploma (Turkish or English translation), OR copy of the document prepared by the school to show the dates of graduation for those who are in the process of graduation and not holding a high school diploma yet  
***\*If the High School diploma was received in other country than Turkey, the applicants must submit the Equivalency Certificate from the Embassies / Consulates of the Republic of Turkey or the Ministry of National Education of the Republic of Turkey, showing that the high school diploma is equivalent to the diplomas obtained from Turkish high schools***
- 3) Copy of Transcript (Turkish or English translation)
- 4) Foreign language and Turkish proficiency certificate (If available)
- 5) Passport
- 6) One (1) photograph (4.5 x 6 cm)
